Post-16 Leadership Development Programme 2021 / 22

The post-16 leadership development programme is aimed at existing, new or aspiring post-16 leaders and has been designed to offer practical advice about the role of a post-16 leader.

This programme offers colleagues the opportunity to develop their knowledge and skills as they prepare for and face the challenges of post-16 leadership and forms part of the national strategy for succession planning.

This programme is an integral part of the work of all four consortia in delivering the national offer for professional learning, and is part of the Leadership Development Pathway at Middle Leader level.

Virtual and bilingual delivery of the programme takes place over 4 four half days (approx. 12 guided learning hours) through presentations, workshops, discussions and practical tasks. Sessions will be delivered by current, experienced post-16 leaders and/or senior leaders and specialist regional colleagues.

The topics covered in the programme include:

- ◆ Understanding the strategic and operational role of post-16 leadership
- ◆ Effective self-evaluation and planning for improvement in the sixth form
- ◆ Planning Interventions and well-being for learners
- ◆ Providing high quality and inclusive advice and guidance to support learner transition, aspirations and chosen destinations
