

South East Wales Headteacher Strategy Group

Terms of Reference: 2022-2023

Purpose and Accountability

The Headteacher Strategy Group is a partnership between schools, local authorities and the Education Achievement Service to inform the strategic direction and evaluation of school improvement work across the region and the identification of future priorities.

The Headteacher Strategy Group is responsible for consulting with and informing the representative bodies of headteachers within each LA and across region.

The Headteacher Strategy Group will work to agreed Terms of Reference that define its purpose and accountabilities.

Membership

Membership of the School Improvement Group will be:

- One primary headteacher and one secondary Headteacher from each individual LA Headteacher Association
- A representative Headteacher from the Special Schools and one from the Pupil Referral Units
- One primary and one secondary headteacher from the Welsh Medium sector
- One representative from regional Leadership Academy Associates
- EAS staff

To ensure that all sectors listed above are represented at all meetings substitute attendees are encouraged if attendance is difficult for a few meetings.

The group will be chaired by a nominated Headteacher from within the group, this will rotate on an annual basis.

The group will invite other officers and representatives of organisations to make a specialist contribution as required.
